## **MATERIALS LIST**

### PAINTS:

Instructor's preferred acrylic paint colours are listed below. They are recommended, not mandatory. Golden and/or Liquitex brand is recommended. Instructor prefers to use heavy body paints as colours are sharper and richer. Bring whatever you have as well.

## Titanium white

Primary magenta

Hansa yellow/Indian yellow - if not available, any shade of cadmium yellow will do cadmium red

Burnt sienna

Ultramarine blue

Teal

.3mm light blue Posca acrylic pen

Paynes gray (optional)

# **PAINTING SURFACES:**

Suggested sizes (you can use whatever you think works best for you). Please prep your surface with a layer of semi transparent warm toned acrylic colour ahead of the class. Instructor usually lays on burnt sienna, yellow ochre or dull crimson.

- 1. Two 12" x 12" (canvas, canvas paper or gessoed wood panele)
- 2. Two 12" x 16".
- 3. One canvas 18" x 24"
- 4. One canvas 24" x 30"

If you already have painting surfaces close to any of these sizes please feel free to use them.

## **BRUSHES**

3 Flat tipped synthetic angled brushes ranging from ¼" - 1" (Zen brand brushes upwards of \$3.99 from DeSerres work quite well). An extra wider brush 1.5" - 2" will be an added bonus when painting on larger canvases.

Assorted palette knives (narrow and long as well as shorter) - plastic ones are fine.

#### **DRAWING TOOLS**

Soft HB pencils, sharpener and kneaded eraser.

**OTHER ITEMS** 

Palette for acrylics (disposable pad is easier)
J cloths, ruler,
¾" - 1" Green or masking tape if using paper.
Table or floor easel (if not available in studio)
2 empty yogurt tubs for water (if not available in studio)
