



Call for Entry – 2025 En Plein Air Competition

What is En Plein Air?

En plein air, a French phrase meaning "in the open air," traditionally describes the process of painting a landscape outdoors. For the NPCC competition, we accept all mediums and encourage artists working in wet and dry media, fabric, fibre and 3D to join in the fun!

Project Description

Neilson Park Creative Centre is excited to announce its En Plein Air Competition on Saturday, July 5 at 12:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Artists are invited to work outdoors in Neilson Park during the Creative Festival that features art and fine craft vendors and live performances, free activities and more! **We welcome all mediums such as painting, drawing, collage, fabric, fibre and 3D.**

Artists may work in a location of their choice: in the woods, with the vendors or musicians – anywhere out-of-doors in Neilson Park or Markland Woods.

Artists must check-in, and may pick up their easels (if needed) inside the Neilson Park Creative Centre between 12:00 p.m. – 12:30 p.m. on July 5. Any time before 4:00 p.m., artists may return the easels and drop off their completed works at the same location inside the Centre. The jurying will take place at 4:15 p.m. sharp with an artists' reception and award ceremony at 4:30 p.m.

The artworks produced during the competition will belong to the artists. Neilson Park Creative Centre reserves the right to use images for promotional purposes.

Competition Categories and Entry Fee

There are two competition categories:

1. Youth, 13 – 17 years of age, free of charge to enter
2. Adults, 18+, \$5.00 entry fee

Awards

Youth category: First, \$100; Second, \$75; Third, \$50

Adult category: First, \$200; Second, \$100; Third, \$75

Registration

Participants are required to register online, by phone or by visiting in person. Registration is complete once registrant information and payment have been received and processed. Deadline to register is Friday, July 4 at 5:00 p.m.

To register on our website, click on the “Explore” tab and select “Call For Artists & Submissions” in the drop-down menu. Under “Plein Air Competition”, click the registration button to make your payment in the shopping cart. We accept payment by credit card in our shopping cart. Youth participants must register although there is no cost.
- By phone
To register by phone, call 416-622-5294 to speak with a customer service representative. Credit card payments are accepted over the phone.
- In person
Please visit us in person to register. We accept payment by credit card, debit, cheque or cash.

Materials

Artists are responsible for bringing their own art supplies, umbrellas and seating, etc. Neilson Park will provide a full-sized easel to each artist. Access to water and public washrooms are available inside Neilson Park Creative Centre.

Size Restrictions and Medium

There are no size restrictions and artists may use any medium on the surface of their choice.

Maria is a landscape painter who works in an impressionistic manner and employs a colorist approach. She creates with both oil and dry pastel mediums.

A nature lover and tireless hiker, Maria finds inspiration in exploring the provincial parks and conservation areas of Southern Ontario. Often painting on location with dry pastels, she captures the light and feeling of each scene. She later uses her pastel sketches as references for larger oil pieces, which she creates in her studio on canvas using a palette knife. By manipulating oil paints wet-on-wet with a palette knife, she blends colors directly on the canvas, creating harmonious transitions and subtle gradients that enhance the textural complexity of her work. Embracing the unpredictability of using a palette knife and allowing the underpainting to show through, she fills her paintings with spontaneity and vitality, making the landscapes feel alive and in motion. The result is a

series of textured pieces that celebrate the beauty of nature and invite viewers to experience it in a tangible, immersive way.

Maria is an Elected Member of the Society of Canadian Artists and the Ontario Society of Artists, as well as a Master Signature Member of Pastel Artists Canada. She lives and works in Mississauga, Ontario, Canada.

Rules and Regulations

- Artists must be registered for the event to participate in the show and awards ceremony.
- Artists may apply grounds to their support of choice prior to check-in.
- Each work of art must be started and completed en plein air (outside). In case of inclement weather, artists may move inside the Centre in a specially designated studio area.
- Artists must provide their own materials.
- Artists may depict any subject/scene outdoors throughout Neilson Park and Markland Woods. This includes the vendor and music areas, parking lot, etc.
- Artwork for the show must be submitted inside Neilson Park Creative Centre by 4:00 pm on Saturday, July 5.
- Artists may select up to 2 pieces of work they created en plein air during the festival for jurying.
- All artwork for the show must have an identifying label attached on the back. Labels can be found on this form and will also be available upon drop-off.
- NPCC staff will set up the artwork for the jurying process.
- Artists may take their work home after the awards ceremony which begins at 4:30 p.m.
- NPCC is not responsible for any artwork left on the premises after the awards ceremony.
