Course: Making Art on Your iPad

MATERIALS LIST

***Procreate** is currently only available for use on an iPad.

- An Apple Pencil is not necessary but will greatly enhance your user experience. A stylus or fingers can also be used.

- iPad
- Apple Pencil - You can use a stylus or your finger, but you won't get the pressure-sensitivity provided by the Pencil
- Procreate App downloaded onto your iPad – available from the App Store
- Power Cord and Power source (if you are using an older iPad, you may find it uses power more quickly – bring an extension cord or a power pack like 'Jackery
- Digital camera, phone camera or iPad camera to source photos
- Reference material – have some photos downloaded onto your iPad that you'd like to work with, such as flowers, textures, people, paintings, etc.

Optional - a stand for your iPad - Paper like iPad Screen protector (or equivalent)
