Course: Collage Maquettes with Kat Honey, **F26AMAQ**

MATERIALS LIST

- **BASIC TOOLS:**
 - Pencils and erasers
 - Non-slip metal rulers: a 12" and a longer one 15"-24"
 - Sketchbook
 - Masking Tape (Painter's preferable — good for temporary holds)
 - Camera (your phone is perfect)
- **CUTTING TOOLS:**
 - Scissors
 - Craft knife/ x-acto with extra blades
 - Cutting mat
- **GLUES:**
 - Glue gun and appropriate glue sticks for it
 - A non-flammable surface to rest your hot glue gun on — a tile, old plate, cookie sheet, or even just a few layers of aluminum foil
 - Regular Glue sticks (I recommend UHU!) bring 2-3, and ensure they're not dried out!
- **FOAMCORE:**
 - Black, white and peel-and-stick*
 - * Staples sells sheets of white foamcore with peel-and-stick adhesive, which isn't strictly necessary, but it sure makes some joins and adding collage materials easy
- **MAT BOARD**
 - In any colours you like — if you have scraps sitting around, bring those
 - Sturdy but flexible thin cardboard and/or paper (for making curved or folded surfaces)
 - Round toothpicks & wooden skewers
- **COLLAGE MATERIALS:**
 - Bring the kinds of collage materials you like to work with!

That could include: books and magazines for images and text, scrapbook papers, maps, patterned and coloured papers, gift wrap, packaging, ephemera, old gel plate prints, Japanese papers, specialty papers, internet printouts, etc.
